General Information

Fresh South, Inc. is a 501 3 C non-profit organization. Its board manages the community garden.

Plots are rented on an annual basis (*Rental period is from January thru November*). The **renewal period** for returning gardeners for the 2022 planting season is **Sept. 5, 2021 – October 17, 2021**. After October 25 plots not reserved by returning gardeners will be open for rental by other parties. A nonrefundable deposit of \$30 is due with registration or payment in full (registration fee plus rental fee) would also be accepted. All fees must be paid in full by November 20, 2021. Returning gardeners may keep their current plot/plots or exchange for any vacated plot. To obtain an additional plot returning gardeners must be on the waiting list and wait their turn.

Rental fee:

8x20 plots \$75.00 (**total 2022 fees \$105 one plot...\$180 two plots**)

8x10 [1/2 plot] \$ 35.00 (**total 2022 fees \$65**)

Non gardening access fee \$25.00 annually

Monies collected are to be used for insurance, city fees, general maintenance of the garden, administrative expenses, tools, repairs, social events, promotional and marketing expenses, educational programs or capital improvements.

Only organic/natural pesticides and fertilizers will be used by gardeners and are supplied by the individual gardener. Vegetable transplants or seeds are provided by gardener. (No trees, bushes, mint or invasive plants are allowed)

RULES

1. Each gardener is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their garden plot and **immediate (12 inches around perimeter)** plot area. Please refrain from using dilapidate, rusted or weather worn items or furniture. Watering, weeding, harvesting and any other garden related maintenance are all the responsibility of the gardener. Gardeners may arrange temporarily for others to tend/water their plots.
2. **ABANDONED GARDENS MAY BE REASSIGNED OR COVERED BY THE BOARD** . A) If a garden is not prepared or planted by April 30, 2022 and the board is not notified as to the reason it will be considered abandoned. The renter will receive a 50% rental fee refund. B) Weeds. ...If a member is notified via email 2 consecutive times within a three (3) week period to weed their garden including 12inches around perimeter and it has not been weeded it will be considered abandoned. (If you are ill or out of town we need to be alerted). No refund will be given unless the renter notifies the board that they cannot maintain their plot. (The maximum refund will be a prorated amount of the rental fee.)
3. Only organic/natural pesticides and fertilizers will be used by gardeners and are supplied by the individual gardener. Vegetable transplants or seeds are provided by the gardener. (No trees, bushes, mint or invasive plants are allowed).
4. For safety and maintenance purposes, all aisles need to be kept clear of tomato cages, trellises, poles, tools or anything else which inhibits walk-ability and safety. Community tools will be returned to the shed for storage and cleaned of debris.
5. Nothing shall be grown on the garden fence or in pots/planters outside of garden plots. Pots maybe used within plots. All plantings must be kept within the inside of a garden plot's perimeter. Garden beds may be raised using wood or compost boards only (no straw beds). All mulch must be biodegradable (the use of leaves, or straw is suggested, no stones, pebbles or other hardscape material). Compost bins are available but the posted guidelines must be followed.
6. Always monitor when watering the garden. Never leave the water on but drain the hose of water replacing it within its irrigation hole and ALWAYS replace cover correctly.
7. Children are welcome in the community garden but must be accompanied by an adult and must be supervised at all times.
8. No animals are allowed within the fenced area.
9. ALWAYS lock the gate AND shed after leaving. **If you unlocked a gate or the shed it is your responsibility to lock them back up even if other gardeners are present.**
10. No nails, screws etc. are to be inserted into the plastic lumber sides of garden plots without permission.

Please be mindful that this is a shared space.
